

Letter **3** may look different to you (it doesn't look like any English letter) but the sound it makes is a simple sound [e] like in egg or exit. The Russian word **3TO** can be translated as this or it. So, try to read and translate these phrases:

Кто это? Это – я. Это – мама. Это – Ия. Это – кот.

Letter \mathbf{C} looks just like the English C. It makes sound [s] as in snow, see, or set. There is one important difference you want to remember about this Russian letter: unlike the English C, it never makes the sound [k]. (Do you remember which letter in Russian makes the sound [k]? That's right, letter \mathbf{K} makes the [k] sound in Russian.) Listen and repeat first, then try to read on your own:

Это – Сэм. This is Sam. **Сэм – кот.** Sam is a cat.

Это – мост. This is a bridge.

Это – сом. This is a catfish.
